What we do:

- Offer classes in ceramics, visual arts, creative writing and dance. Classes are held year-round, with a nominal registration fee of only **\$10 per 8-week course**. Recent classes include Lindy Hop, African Drum, Adult/Child Ceramics, Stop Motion Animation, Spoken Word, Ballet and Mural Drawing.
- Offer opportunities for local artists to teach, volunteer, and exhibit their work.
- Host cultural events including performances, exhibitions, special workshops and panel discussions.

Who we serve:

- People ages 2 and older in Baltimore's underserved Sandtown-Winchester, Upton, and surrounding neighborhoods.

Jubilee Arts is located on the historic Pennsylvania Avenue, the heart of African-American arts and entertainment in Baltimore for decades. While the Avenue once nurtured artists such as Billie Holliday and Cab Calloway, the area has struggled in the recent past with poverty, drugs, and violence. But through Jubilee Arts classes, cultural events, public art projects, opportunities for local artists, and partnerships, we are all helping to revive the once proud arts legacy of the Avenue and the community at large.

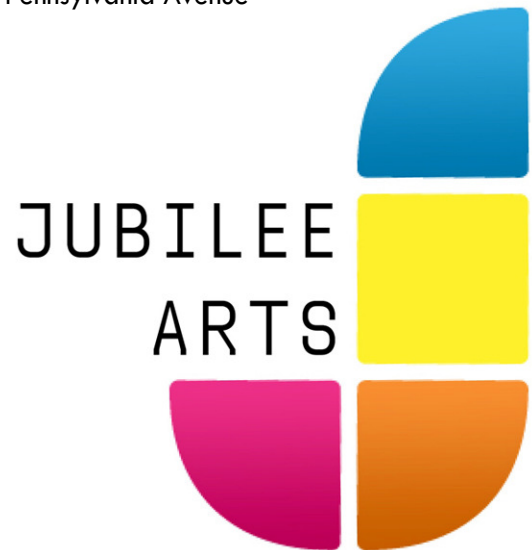
